A quick reminder that our topic for this half term is 'Starting with a story'. This will allow us to use the children's interests and ideas as a basis for our planning. We are asking that the children can bring in one special book that they really like and can talk to their friends about. It would be helpful if you can discuss their books at home before they bring their book to school please. It really can be any book they like at all, information, story, magazines, anything goes! Please make sure that their name is on their book somewhere. In addition to this, we will be starting our phonics work when we learn all about letters and sounds. We will be looking for objects in the sand tray that start with the letter 's'. We will be reading lists of ingredients to make some yucky cakes. We will be singing lots of number songs and practicing our counting beyond 20.

We will be looking again at our African Land Snails and thinking of names for them.
