Literacy

This week is 'National Road Safety' week and so we continue our topic of transport by talking about staying safe when we are out and about. We will be talking about finding a safe place to cross the road with our adults and what we can do to be seen during these dark nights. You might want to talk about this with your children at home.

Maths

In maths we will be introducing the topic of money. We will be looking at the different coins and notes that we use and have a go at sorting them. We will be using £1.00 coins and £2.00 coins to buy things from our pretend shop. When you are out and about with your children you might want to let them pay for some shopping in the shop with some coins. Talk to them about the different coins that you have in your purse or pocket.



Topic

We will be talking about the different colours we see on traffic lights and then we will be investigating how we can make the colour of our torch light change and thinking about what we can use to make this happen. We will make some funny glasses using coloured cellophane and have a go at making paper aeroplanes. We will then go outside to have a competition to see whose aeroplane will fly the furthest.
