Reception will go swimming after lunch. Swimming things, no earrings and £2.00 please.




Friday

This week is all about aliens loving underpants. I know, it sounds bizarre but there really are books about this topic! We will be reading 'Aliens love underpants,' 'Aliens in underpants save the world' and 'Aliens love dinopants.' These are written by the author Clare Freedman. If you have any more of these books by the same author, please send them in.



Literacy

We will be reading all of these books and identifying the pairs of rhyming words on each page. We will look at the spelling rules of these. We will label pictures of aliens, remembering to always write from left to right which can be quite tricky when labelling.

Maths

In maths this week we will be revising our knowledge of 2D and 3D shapes. We will talk about the properties of these and look at every day packaging such as boxes, tubes and cartons of various 3D shapes. We will also be ordering some aliens using ordinal numbers from 1st to 10th.

Topic

We will listen to a piece of music by Gustav Holts called the planet suite and talk about the instruments we can hear, how it makes us feel and how we would move to the music. We will be designing a pair of underpants and hanging them on a washing line. We will make hand and footprint aliens using goggly eyes, pompoms and other creative resources. We will also look at the fabric that underpants are made from and talk about this.
