School starts at 8.45 for Reception and 12.15 for Nursery.

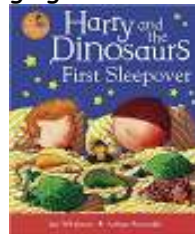
Thursday 8th June - School closed for General Election day.

Literacy

We will be writing more speech bubbles for the different characters in the story of Harry and the dinosaurs' sleepover. We will have a go at making up our own Harry story.

Maths

We will practice counting in twos and ordering numbers from the two times table. You could do this at home when you count 2p coins, socks, or arms and legs.

Topic

We will be looking at the different fabrics that we would make a sleeping bag for the dinosaurs from. We will talk about how to join the fabrics and materials together and have a go at making one. We will also be talking about how to keep our teeth healthy by brushing them and eating healthy foods.
