Celebration assembly at 2.45. Everyone welcome.

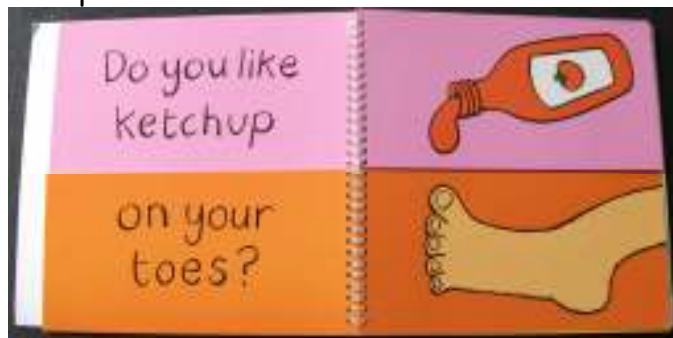
A reminder to please apply sunscreen on hot days and send some in to school so that we can help your child to reapply it.

We continue our Nick Sharratt theme and look at some split page books this week. They are extremely silly mix-up books. The first is called 'Ketchup on your cornflakes' and the other is called 'Accidentally on Purpose.'



In literacy we will make up our own silly questions along the same theme. We will also be practicing our handwriting and continuing our phonics work every day.

In maths we will be collecting and interpreting data about all kinds of things including eye colour, traffic and types of transport. We will also be completing number lines with some missing numbers.

In topic time we will be reading the tradition tale of Jack and the beanstalk. We will talk about what plants need to grow before planting our own bean seed. We will also discuss all the types of beans that are available to buy and how they are sold as fresh vegetables, frozen vegetables and tinned vegetables.
