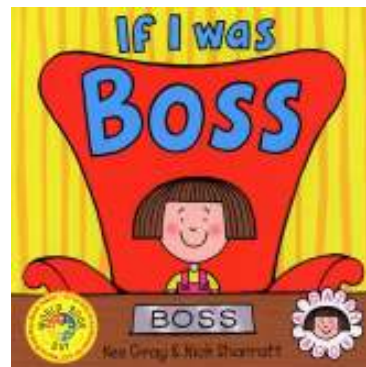
Celebration assembly at 2.45. Everyone welcome.
