PE will be on Friday this week for Reception children and their PE bags will need to be on their pegs. The children had a fantastic time last week and loved every minute of it. A quick reminder to remove earrings before school on a Friday thank you.

We have a whole school celebration assembly on a Friday afternoon at 2.45 pm in the hall and everyone is welcome to attend. It gives us an opportunity to celebrate the fantastic children that we have at North Walney and their amazing achievements every week.

Reception - Please change reading books once or twice a week and ensure your child is reading at home as much as possible.



This week sees us starting with a book called 'The Farm Concert'. It is a lovely story about a grumpy farmer who can't get any sleep because the animals are making too much noise. We will be basing our literacy work around the story and writing speech bubbles for different farm animals. We will be using the construction toys to make a vehicle to carry an animal and designing a crate using the junk modelling. In maths we will be having a 2D shape week. We will be naming as many shapes as we can, talking about their properties and using them to make pictures with. You might want to look for shapes at home. In phonics nursery will be listening to sounds in the environment, naming them and using their voices to make funny sounds. Reception will be revising the letter sounds s, a, t and p that we learnt last week.



I have been busy setting up the 'parent share' option for observations that we do in school. If you haven't already done so, please check your emails to confirm them so that I can begin sending you observations of the fantastic things that your children do in school. This is an amazing opportunity for us to share information about your children and you can reply to the email so that we can print these out to put in their learning journeys. You can also submit your own photos or videos and we can also enter these into your child's learning journey.
