Nursery and Reception news

In class this week

In Literacy this week we will be reading another Oxford Reading Tree book all about Floppy the dog. We will be making sentences using the characters from our stories and joining them with the word 'and'. You might want to look out for this word when you are out and about. In phonics we continue to practice sounding and blending to read simple words such as c-u-p, d-o-g and m-a-n. Nursery will continue to listen for sounds in the environment and explore the sounds that different musical instruments make.



In maths we will be making number sentences. The children will be challenged to share 5 objects between two groups and find the number sentence to match. Eg $4 + 1 = 5$. $3 + 2 = 5$.

In topic time, we will spend the last two weeks of the half term talking about Harvest time. This week sees us reading several versions of The Little Red Hen. We will talk about the characters, setting and endings. We will have a go at baking our own bread and marveling at the small number of ingredients that go together to bake something so delicious. You might want to look at the different kinds of bread that are available in the shops.
