

Topic

Welcome back. I do hope you have had a lovely break with your children. This half term is all about the seaside and we start our topic by finding out what the children already know and what they might like to find out. This week we are reading lots of stories about a lighthouse keeper and his wife. The first of which is about the lighthouse keeper's lunch and the seagulls keep pinching his sandwiches. We will be making sandwiches and feeding them to the seagulls to find out what kind of fillings they like the best.

Literacy

We will continue to practice our phonics every day. We will be listening to a collection of 'The lighthouse keeper' stories. Nursery will cut and stick picnic foods in a basket and Reception will write a list of picnic foods that they like. They will also be challenged to write instructions about how to make a sandwich.



Mathematics

This week is all about collecting and interpreting data. We will be making tally marks to find out how many of each eye colour are in our class before visiting another class to collect data. We will also make a bar chart and a pictogram for different sweet colours (which always grabs their attention!) They will also be challenged to carry out a traffic survey of vehicles passing our school.

Our weather continues to be very changeable and we can see weather from one extreme to the other. On hot days, please ensure that your child comes to school with sun cream already applied and put some in your child's bag and a sun hat. We will then encourage them to reapply it when necessary to ensure your child is safe in the sun. I am sure you can appreciate that if we have to apply sun cream to 30 children before we can go out each day, this is very time consuming, not to mention expensive!
