


Thank you so much for allowing the children to bring their favourite books to school. There seems to be a few common themes. These are animals, particularly dogs, dinosaurs, princesses and traditional tales so this week sees us starting with a book called Spot goes shopping by Eric Hill. This is Layla's favourite story and it is all about Spot the dog going shopping with his mum. If your child hasn't yet brought their favourite story book to school, there is still plenty of time to do so.

We will be basing our literacy work around the story and writing shopping lists and talking about how to take care of a pet dog which is something lots of our children can relate to. We will be using the construction toys to make a dog cage and changing our role play area to include pet dogs. In maths we will be having a 2D shape week. We will be naming as many shapes as we can, talking about their properties and using them to make pictures with. You might want to look for shapes at home.

In topic time we will bake some cakes, just like Spot did and decorate them.

In phonics nursery will be listening to sounds in the environment, naming them and using their voices to make funny sounds. Reception will be learning and revising the letter sounds s, a, t and p.

If your child needs an inhaler or any other medication, please ensure that I have medication that is in date and that it is in a bag clearly labelled with their name. If there is any other information that I need to know, including shared parenting etc., please feel free to talk to me in confidence.

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
