Nursery and Reception news

In class this week

In Literacy this week we will be reading more Oxford Reading Tree books all about Mum, Dad and Floppy the dog. We will be learning the word 'and' and making up silly alliterative phrases for our own names like Munching Millie, Jumping George and Bouncing Bobby. You could play this silly game at home with other names from your family. In phonics we continue to practice sounding and blending to read simple words such as c-u-p, d-o-g and m-a-n. Nursery will continue to listen for sounds in the environment and explore the sounds that different musical instruments make.



In maths we will be making number sentences. The children will be challenged to share 5 objects between two groups and find the number sentence to match. Eg $4 + 1 = 5$. $3 + 2 = 5$.

In topic time, we will spend the last two weeks of the half term talking about Harvest time and wait for it..... making Christmas cards ready to be sent off for printing so that you can place your orders in time for Christmas. We will also be using our new class ipads. A huge thank you to Mr Slater for allowing us to purchase these to be used in Pre-school, Nursery and Reception.

Individual and family photographs were taken today and will be back in time for orders to be placed in time for Christmas, making ideal presents.
