Nursery and Reception news


Dates for your diary:

Literacy

This week we will be reading the lovely story of Zog. He is the keenest dragon in school but a little hapless to say the least. He goes to dragon school to learn how to fly, how to roar, how to breathe fire and how to capture princesses. We will be writing rhyming strings to rhyme with Zog. You can try saying this with your children. Zog, bog, dog, fog etc. We will also have a go at writing instructions to tell Zog how to fly.

Maths

Nursery continue to practice recognition of numerals and doing activities such as jumping, clapping and hopping, remembering to stop at the correct number. This is trickier than you think! We will practice our skills of saying the number that is one more than and then two more than and we will begin to have a go at writing the number sentences to show this.

Topic

We will be finding out some information about a Komodo dragon. We will also be having a go at a Chinese dragon dance. We will find out information about the importance of red in the Chinese culture and the giving of red money envelopes to signify luck and prosperity. We will be making paper chain dragons and playing with chop sticks and noodles in the water tray and lots, lots more.
