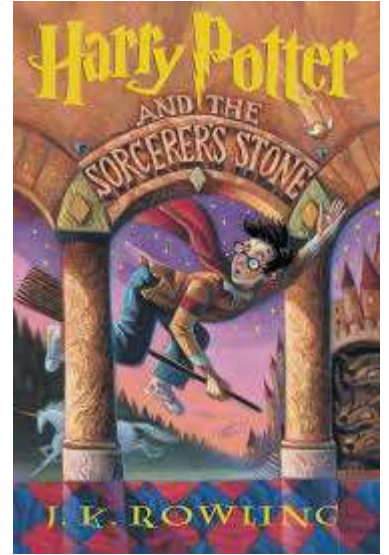
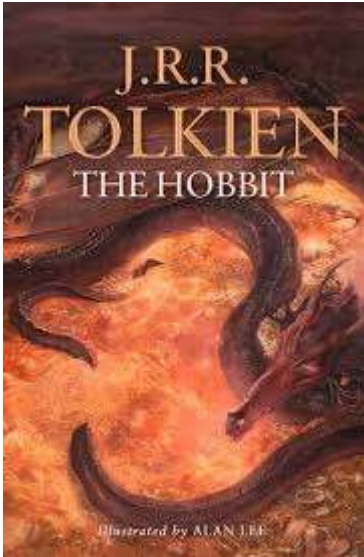


World Book Day

MAGIC!

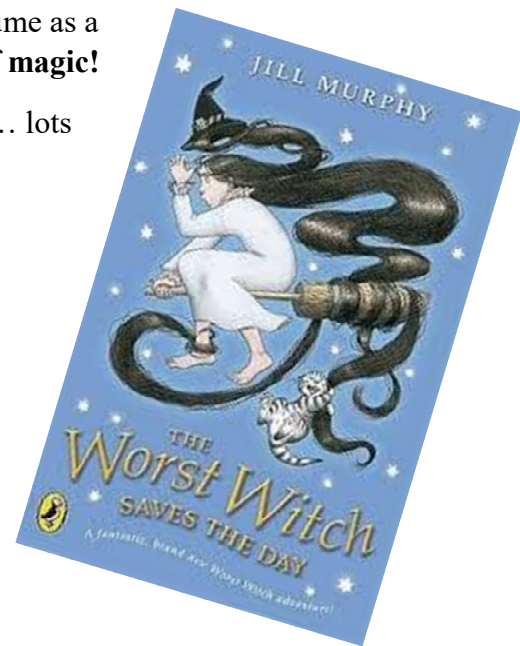
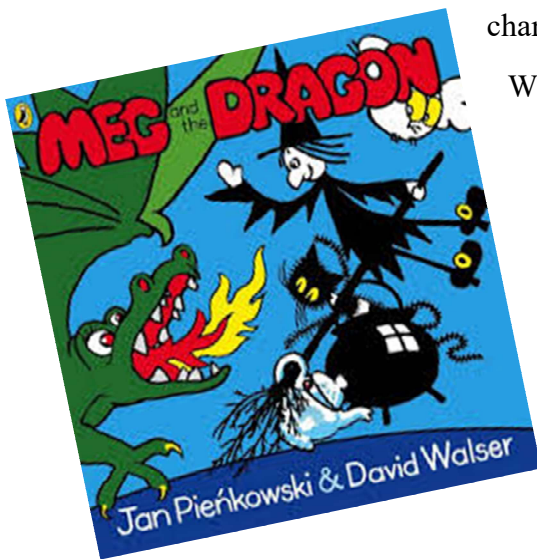


Children can come, on Friday 8th March, in costume as a character from a book with the theme of **magic!**
