Dear Parents/Guardians,

This week, the Year 6 children and the remaining Year 4 and 5s will be joining me in the Owl class for their learning over the week. We will register in the morning together and then split off into our learning groups. In order to ensure the Year 6 children are still on track for their upcoming SATs, Mrs Andrews will be working with the Year 6 children every morning for Maths and English; Mrs Andrews is a very experienced Year 6 facilitator and the children know her very well. The expectations will be high and I will oversee their progress over the week.

The children in Year 3, 4 and 5 will be undertaking a DT project about Seasonal Foods. We will be making and discussing, tasting and evaluating foods. Look out for recipe cards and meal ideas to try out at home!

In the afternoons, we will recombine to carry out some work on France, one of our closest European countries. We will be looking at where in the world Paris is, tourist attractions, food and the language. We will be using google maps to gauge an idea of the size of Paris compared to London and create a final piece of work at the end of the week.

**YEAR 6** will need to think about a journey they have been on that they thought was life changing. They might want to make sketches or have photos of their special trip to use as an aid to their work on Wednesday afternoon. On Wednesday, they will be transforming their journey and experience into a piece of abstract art using symbols and patterns to relay their feelings about their experiences.

**YEAR 3/4/5** will need to bring a selection of images of fruits and vegetables for Wednesday morning. This will form part of their DT work: can be images from the internet, photos, from packaging or magazines like ALDI that pop through the door.

On Thursday, we all take part in YOGA, so kit is essential and we will also all be going swimming.
