Follow-up day visits – Years 4 and 5

Dear Parents and Carers,

The children had a fantastic time at Water Park and were really well behaved. It can be a difficult week because they are kept so busy and get really tired but I was really proud of them all in the way that they preserved and challenged themselves. They really are a credit to you all. I have lots of photos which will soon but put on the school website.

I mentioned in my first letter about the residential that there would also be 2 day visits for the children in April so they can further develop their skills and confidence. However, now the time has come, I feel that the timing of the visits may not be right so close after a residential trip. However, I would like to offer your child a place on the day visits but I fully understand if you do not wish for your child to attend.

The day **visit are on Wednesday 17th April and Thursday 18th April**. The **cost for the 2 visit will be £26**. There is no cost for transport and the Eric Wright trust have kindly agreed to support the trip financially. The day visits usually cost £26 per day.

The programme for the day visits has not yet been organised. We will use mini buses to transport the children to and from Water Park. The children will need a packed lunch for the day and we will probably return to school 4.15pm on both days.

If you would like your child to attend the 2 day visits, please complete and **return the Water Park medical form by Wednesday 13th March**. This will then secure your child's place. The trip doesn't need to be paid until Monday 15th April (£26). If I don't receive the medical form by Wednesday, I will offer the spare places to children in other classes.

I really hope that it is possible for your child to attend. The children really do gain such a lot from Water Park visits.
