EYFS Kidsafe programme outline & parent/carer invite to information sessions

Dear Parents/carers,

Kidsafe is a specialised Child Protection Programme which will be delivered into school to the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) children.

The EYFS Kidsafe programme deals with building children's confidence, self esteem and equips children with effective skills to deal with unsafe situations. Kidsafe enables children to value themselves and others, and helps children to make wise and healthy choices and decisions in their lives. Kidsafe teaches children to recognise and/or prevent unsafe situations identifying what's safe and alright and what's not safe and not right, this is done in a fun, age appropriate way through a variety of methods including the use of our puppet KS, games, singing and worksheets.

Topics covered during the course include:- raising self confidence, feelings: talking about our feelings, bullying, communication skills, saying No, computer/internet safety and age ratings on DVDs and films.

In order that we can give more information about the EYFS Kidsafe programme the Kidsafe trained tutor we will be offering two parent/carer information sessions to be held in school. The date and times are below; please note you need only attend **one** of the sessions.
