# Nursery and Reception class news

## Topic time

Last week we voted on what we would like this week's topic to be and the children decided on 'things that fly.' This can be anything! We will talk about things that can fly such as birds, planes, hot air balloons, drones plus a whole multitude of animals. We will be reading an information book about things that fly and have a go at making paper aeroplanes, kites, hot air balloons and roto-copters. We will also be checking on our Hairy heads and Hairy Harrys that we made last week.



## Literacy and Numeracy

We will be talking about things that fly and choosing something to draw a label. We will be thinking about whether all things that have wings can fly or do things even need wings to fly!

In maths the children will be collecting and interpreting data. They will name 2D and 3D shapes and talk about the properties of them.

At home this week you may like to:

- Have a go at making a paper aeroplane and seeing how far it will fly.
- Look at things growing in the garden.
- Name 2D shapes around your house.
