Topic time

This week the children have decided that our topic will be 'cats.' We will talk about domestic and wild cats and the similarities and differences between the two. We will talk about pet cats that we may have at home and how to take care of them. We will be having a go at origami when we try to fold paper to make a cat's head. Literacy and Numeracy

We will be reading lots of cat stories and looking at non fiction books about cats. The children will be challenged to sort a collection of cat books into fiction and non fiction.

In maths, Nursery will be playing lots of counting games. Reception will be practicing their number facts and learning to solve simple single digit addition sums by collecting resources to find out how many altogether. We will then have a go at counting on to find the answer.

At home this week you may like to:

- Play simple dice games.
- Count how many cats you see on the way to and from school.
- Ask your child to get three objects and four more and count how many altogether, changing the amounts each time.

As we didn't go swimming last week, if you paid, there is no need to pay this week as the money will be carried forwards.
