Celebration assembly at 2.45. Everyone welcome.


Thursday 4th July

Reception need to bring their book bags to school every day please and should be reading two or three times a week at home.

This week our learning is based around the topic of socks! Strange I know but there are some fabulous stories that really help the children to think about their own and others feelings.

One of the stories we will be having is called; 'Simon Sock' by Sue Hendra. Simon is a sock, an only, lonely sock who never gets picked! The children will consider what this would feel like. Don't worry, he does find a partner in the end - but not the one you expect!



We will be making our own sock puppet using different resources. Please ensure that your child has an adult sock in their drawer that they can make into a sock puppet. We would also like to talk about our favourite pair of socks too so please ensure that your child has theirs in their drawer. It would be useful if you could talk about why they are their favourites.

In maths, Nursery will be playing games to recognise numerals and collecting objects to match to numerals. Reception are learning about place value and explore this using sticks of tens and ones. The children will be counting how many cubes there are and will be looking at how 14 is one lot of ten and four ones etc. At home you might like to look for numerals in the environment such as house numbers, bus numbers and car registrations.
